(Boss: 11/24/07 ~ 9/28/19)

"Boss came to me in 2010 at the age of three to be my service dog. He had to hit the ground running as I needed his assistance immediately. Since he had not been raised to be a Service Dog, I did not want to challenge or confuse him with trying to fulfill both jobs of Service and Therapy right away. So we became a team with Alliance of Therapy Dogs in the fall of 2014 and became active in both therapy and R.E.A.D. Boss may not have had as many years of participation in therapy and R.E.A.D. as some other dogs, but he excelled at and LOVED both, nonetheless. He was loved and requested by many children and adults alike."
