
Germany

As we anticipate the official 15th anniversary of the beginning of Reading Education Assistance Dogs program, it is so rewarding and to see how this program has grown. This growth is due to you, the dedicated therapy animal teams that make this happen day after day, week after week.

Through the years, the R.E.A.D. training manual has continually evolved and been updated to include the latest information. And, as you know, the manual was just redesigned for the 15th anniversary and is now quite striking with its new format and colored pictures. There are over 11,000 manuals in circulation.

There are R.E.A.D. members in all 50 states – yeah! Over 4560 teams have become R.E.A.D. members. (We know all those other manuals have inspired other non-R.E.A.D. programs!)

We are thrilled to support the brave teams that have started R.E.A.D. affiliates in their own countries. We currently have affiliates in thirteen countries: Canada, Croatia, England/United Kingdom, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Norway, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, and Sweden. Additional manuals have been sold in eleven other countries that will hopefully become future affiliates: Australia, Brazil, Columbia, Greece, Japan, Iceland, Israel, New Zealand, Poland, Portugal, and Romania.

The growth of the R.E.A.D. program is very exciting, not so much for the statistics but for the difference you have made in the lives of all of the children you and your R.E.A.D. partner have impacted. And, we must acknowledge and appreciate the essential role your therapy animal has in R.E.A.D.'s success. Without your R.E.A.D. animal's willingness to patiently listen to "Go, Dog. Go!" one more time, there wouldn't be much of a program. Thank you!
